

NAVIGATING ADA NEEDS

Because our event takes place on a historic campus, parking availability is limited.

We ask all vendors to assess their individual needs and, when possible, choose a location that is farther away. This helps ensure that closer, more accessible spaces remain available for those who rely on them most.

We are committed to supporting your ADA needs to the best of our ability. Notifying us in advance allows us to better assist you.

Ways we can support you:

- **Make a plan:** Contact us to discuss options tailored to your needs.
- **Intentional booth placement:** We will place you in the most accessible location available.
- **Intentional load-in times and locations:** We will plan times that allow you to be as close as possible during setup.
- **Converted ADA spaces:** Please refer to the Vendor ADA Map.
- **ADA drop-off passes:** These allow drop-off and pick-up along West Circle Drive when the road is otherwise restricted.

Converted to ADA: Some areas may appear as employee or metered parking. MSU PD has approved all spaces as ADA parking for this event, except those marked reserved or designated for university vehicles. These spaces are only available to vendors.



Patron ADA: We ask you do not use the 7 ADA spaces along Abbot Rd. Instead, park in the converted ADA lot behind Campbell Hall. We will be able to support more individuals with ADA needs if these are not occupied for the full day.
