COMMON FAQs

Emergencies:

- The information booth on every floor can respond to any concerns of vendors/patrons and also provide guidance in the event of an emergency.
- We encourage you to sign up for MSU Alerts by going to <u>alert.msu.edu</u> and registering as a guest.
- Vendors are required to use our emergency alert system, Nixle. Click <u>here</u> to sign up.

Restrooms:

- Restrooms are located on all four (4) floors of the MSU Union. Unisex bathrooms are located on the Fourth and Ground floors.
- Nursing Mothers Rooms are located on the 1st Floor of the MSU Union and a key can be checked out at the Welcome Desk.

Accessibility:

- The only accessible ramp is located on the West side of the building near Abbott Rd.
- All levels are accessible via our elevators.
- Accessible parking is available for vendors. Please contact show directors for more information.

Show Staff:

- There is one Information booth per floor.
- The Show HQ is located on the **1st Floor, near MSU FCU**.
- Show staff is on-site at all times. Two show directors are available at all times.
- Please note the building does not open until 9 AM on Sunday.
- Unfortunately, we are not able to provide Booth Sitters.

Food:

- The MSU Union convenience store is located on the 1st floor.
- The Union Food Court is closed for renovations. We highly encourage vendors to make plans for meals.
- Our new coffee shop, locally owned and operated Strange Matter has opened.
- Complimentary coffee is available for vendors in the Show Headquarters!

Evaluation

Storage and Security:

- Storage can be purchased on Zapplication. It is locked at all times your info booth can provide access. It is shared with multiple vendors.
- We provide security from the time the show closes until the building is locked.

Tips for a Smooth Show

A smooth and successful show requires coordination. To help us provide the best experience for all show staff, volunteers, vendors, and patrons, please follow the rules below.

Load-In:

- Please do not arrive before your load-in time and adhere to the <u>time and</u> <u>location</u> you are scheduled for load-in.
- Have your booth number and load-in pass ready when entering MSU.
- Do not set up your booth or go to dinner until you move your vehicle from the load-in zone. The goal of the load-in zone is to unload your items and quickly move the vehicle.
- If you need adjustments to load-in times, please <u>complete the form</u> on the load-in information by **Thursday**, **December 5th.** No changes are possible after that time.

During the Show:

- Be kind and courteous to your fellow vendors and show staff.
- Start your day with a caffeine boost! Vendors can find complimentary tea and coffee at the Show Headquarters, located on the 1st floor near MSU FCU.

Load-out:

- Review the requirements for Load-Out Passes.
- Do not retrieve your vehicle until you have received a Load-Out Pass. Do not send another party to retrieve your vehicle before you have received your load-in pass.
- Be patient as our staff manages a high volume of vendors.
- Complete our show evaluation so we can improve your experience in future years!

Our historic building has a single accessible entry.

Load-in and Load-out required high levels of coordination. We appreciate vendors working with us to create a smooth experience!
